CASE SUMMARY:

Emily Herrold

Sassietats Camden (Camden) is an 11 month old FI Maine Coon presenting to OSU Cardiology Service today for a breeding certificate. Her general physical examination did not reveal any cardiac abnormalities. An echocardiogram was performed. Please see below for a summary of diagnostics.

Diagnostics:

• Echocardiogram: Normal cardiac structure and function. F

INSTRUCTIONS:

Monitoring and respiratory rate:

Please monitor Sassietats Camden for signs of heart disease or heart failure such as exercise intolerance, weakness, labored or fast breathing, a progressive trend upwards in respiratory rate, coughing, abdominal distension, or fainting. Call OSU-VMC Cardiology or your referring veterinarian if any of these signs occur.

Diet

In general, diets that are grain-free, contain exotic ingredients, or are not manufactured by a reputable company should be avoided since they have been linked to dilated cardiomyopathy. Additionally, diets that contain alternative carbohydrate sources such as chickpeas, lentils, sweet potatoes, beet pulp, or peas, even if they are grain inclusive, should be avoided. We suggest using a heavily researched brand such as Purina Pro Plan, Royal Canin, Hill's Science Diet, or Eukanuba. Provide fresh water at all times.

ASSESSMENT AND PROGNOSIS:

Camden is assessed as apparently healthy today, which is great news! Her echocardiogram was within normal limits. She does not have any evidence of cardiac disease.

FOLLOW UP:

1) We recommend annual echocardiographic reassessments of Sassietats Camden's heart while she is breeding. We will contact you next week if there are additional considerations after his echocardiogram report is finalized. Please schedule her recheck appointments as soon as you are able to do so since we are booking out a few months in advance.

NOTE: If you have scheduled an appointment in advance but cannot make this appointment, please contact us as soon as possible so we can alter the appointment date/time. Our available appointment slots are very limited and we can better accommodate visits for pets with emergent needs if we are provided proper notice of appointment cancellation.
