Normal Heart Echocardiographically

No heart murmur.

CASE SUMMARY:

The current prognosis for Duran's heart health is very good. This screening ("CERF") examination did not reveal any evidence of congenital or acquired heart disease. On auscultation, no murmur was detected. The absence of disease today does not preclude the development of heart disease in the future. Some disorders, such as hypertrophic cardiomyopathy (HCM) are classified as adult-onset, genetic heart diseases (age-related disease penetrance). These may develop later in life, and for this reason the examination findings today should be interpreted as "normal for this time frame". We would like to see Duran again for a recheck in one year to re-evaluate his echocardiograph since HCM can develop later in life, even after having a normal initial screening examination.

Diagnostics:

- Echocardiogram: No abnormalities detected. Normal LV wall thickness (4-5 mm). Normal LA size. Normal LV systolic and diastolic function. No outflow tract obstruction. Normal ECG without ectopy.

ASSESSMENT AND PROGNOSIS:

No abnormalities noted today but continue to monitor. No breeding concerns at this time.

FOLLOW UP:

1) We should see Ruffians Duran Duran Of H back in 1 year for the following diagnostics: Recheck CERF echocardiogram. Please schedule this appointment 3-5 months in advance.
